## **School Annual Report 2019-20**

Sisters, members of the school management council and PTA executive committee, our esteemed parents, my colleagues, student leaders and dear students, I am extremely happy to stand before you to present the annual school report of the academic year 2019-20.

Our school, BTC Public School started as a sister concern of MAMHSS Puthencruz under St. Mary's Charitable Trust and is managed by the Rev. Sisters of St. Mary's Convent Puthencruz. The school was opened in June 2004 under the patronage of our Catholicose HB. Dr. Baselius Thomas I<sup>st</sup> . The school had a humble beginning with 130 students and 8 teachers. We have achieved tremendous progress during the last 15 years. At present we have 1219 students and 71 members of staff on the roll.

**Extension of Affiliation and Recognition:-** This academic year is a special one for us. An inspection team of the CBSE visited our school in the month of July in connection with the Extension of Affiliation with CBSE. And I am glad to inform you that our school successfully scaled through the inspection and obtained extension of affiliation for another five more years. I am also indeed happy to inform you that the state government has sanctioned us the long awaited Recognition to our school. I take this opportunity to thank all the members of the staff and the management for extending their co-operation and support in making the inspection process a grand success.

**Academic Achievements:-** This year the school reopened on 6th June 2019 and we follow the curriculum designed by the CBSE and NCERT. We have already presented nine batches of 10<sup>th</sup> class students for the CBSE board Exams .I am immensely happy to inform you that in all these years 100% of our students

passed the 10<sup>th</sup> exams with distinction and first class. In the last 10<sup>th</sup> class Board Exam conducted in March 2019, out of 47 students appeared, 45 secured distinction and 2 got first class. In addition to this 6 students secured 100% marks in Social Science We have received an award from the MLA of Kunnathunadu Constituency, Sri. V.P. Sajeendran for achieving 100% pass in the 10<sup>th</sup> class examination. I take this opportunity to thank all our teachers, parents and students for this excellent performance.

In addition to this we impart special training in various co-curricular activities like athletics, games, art, music and dance. We also provide free training in Karate to both boys and girls studying in class VI to IX. This year also we organized summer coaching camps for Athletics and Football during the months of April and May

**Infrastructure and other facilities :-** The school has all the necessary infrastructural facilities needed for a full fledged secondary school. We have well equipped labs for Science, Mathematics, and Computer Science. In addition to this we have an English language lab, 3 digital class rooms and a well furnished library. The construction of the new Nursery and Primary block was completed in the month of May this year and the nursery and classe1&2 started functioning in the new block in June itself. The new block contains 20 spacious class rooms and all other allied facilities for our junior students.

**PTA and Student council:** - Our school has an active PTA. Sri. Basil Thampi Kunnath is our elected PTA President for this academic year and he is supported by a 20 Member Executive Committee. We have an elected Student Council. Master Baisil Jacob and Kumari Liya Mary Kuriakose are elected as the Head Boy and Head girl respectively.

**Counselling classes:-** The school has organized a counseling class for the parents of nursery and primary children in the month of August. A counseling cum carrier guidance class was conducted for the students of class X in October. To promote interaction between parents and teachers, two class wise PTA meetings were held in July and October

**School Clubs and Activities:-** Various school clubs associated with Science, Mathematics, Social science, Literary, Environment and Health are functioning in the school. Our school magazine 'Baselian Herald' is published every year by

the Literary club. Every year we organize school exhibition with active participation of these clubs. In order to encourage reading habits of our students the school provides 'Decan Chronicle' news paper at subsidized rate. This year more than 450 students availed this opportunity. A book exhibition was conducted in the month of July to encourage the students to purchase and read books of knowledge. This year we started Class Libraries in each class with the active contribution from the students. A study tour to Ooty was organized for the senior students in the month of October.

**Festivals and celebrations:-** This year we have celebrated Onam, Independence Day, Teacher's Day and Children's Day with colour full activities. The school youth festival was held on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> of August. The competitions were held on the basis of four houses, Kids Fest for the KG students was conducted on 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> of October and the School Annual Sports meet was organized on 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> of November

**Participation in External Competitions:-** During this academic year our students showed excellent performance in the fields of Sports and Art competitions. 41 of our students participated in the Central Kerala Sahodaya Sports Meet conducted at Viswadeepthi Public School Adimali, Our students won 10 medals in the events and overall 5<sup>th</sup> position in the Athletic Meet. Kumari Alna Mariya Babu and Kumari Karen Job won Gold Medals in Shot Put and 200 meters race respectively. 9 students of our school participated in the State CBSE Athletic Meet held at Maharajas College ground Ernakulam. Our junior Foot Ball team participated in the Sahodaya Foot Ball competition held at Viswajyothi CMI Public School Angamali.

I take this opportunity to thank and congratulate our Physical Education teachers Sri. Saifu Rahuman and Miss Chippy. T.S. for their dedicated effort in coaching our students for all these competitions.

A team of 33 students participated in the Central Kerala Sahodya Youth Festival. Our school won a total of 119 points in the different cultural competitions. Two of our students participated in the State Level Youth festival conducted at Carmel Public school Vazhakkulam. Master Deon Reji and Muhammed Jassil K.N. won first prize with A grade in Power Point Presentation. Maser Deon Reji also won second prize with A grade in English Extempore. I

take this opportunity to congratulate both for this remarkable achievements. Our students also participated in various quiz competitions and Drawing and Painting competitions and won prizes.

**Staff enrichment programmes:-** The Principal and teachers from all the departments attended various in-services courses and teacher empowerment programmes conducted by the CBSE, Sahodaya Complex and other agencies at different centers. Our school is also participating actively in the Hub of Learning Programmes as directed by the CBSE. We conducted one principle conference and two teacher training programmes in English Language and Mathematics as a part of Hub of Learning activities

**Prizes and Endowments:-** To encourage our students in their pursuit for scholastic excellence the school awards proficiency prizes to the best of students selected from each class. Special prizes are awarded to the students of class 10 who scored more than 90% marks in the Board Exam and also to those who scored 100% marks in individual subjects. Prizes and certificates are also given to students for their performance in Sports, Youth Festivals and other extracurricular activities

An Endowment constituted in memory of Late A.I. Ouseph sir, our former Principal is awarded to the student for the excellent performance in Social science. This year it is awarded to Master Deon Reji of class 10 A.
